## Inserting Media

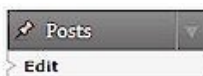

## Inserting from a New Post

For this tutorial, find a picture on your computer to upload. Sign in to your site. Click the **New Post** link. This will redirect you to the **Add New Post** page. Input a title for the post and some text in the content area. (Keep the text simple, like "This is a picture of me.")

From the Dashboard page, click the **Edit** sublink from the **Posts** header located in the sidebar link tables. This redirects you to the **Edit Posts** page where you can view a list of your posts.



The **Edit Posts** page displays a list of your posts. Clicking the post's title redirects you to an **Edit Post** page that contains the content of that particular post.

Clicking the **Return to Theme Installer** link returns you to your **Install Themes** page where you can search for more themes.

**NOTE:** If your original theme and new theme don't have the same number of sidebars or columns, some of your widgets may not appear correctly.

## Custom Header

*Customize Header* Clicking this sublink redirects you to the **Customize Header** page where you can change the look of the header that appears on the front page of your site.
